Dear Fellow Club Member/Coach,

We, Newtown Wanderers, are holding a football festival 5th and 6th May 2007. We would like to invite teams from your club to attend this festival, which will be held at Broadwood Football Stadium (home to Clyde FC). Newtown Wanderers are entering teams at the following age groups; Clubs can enter more than one team at each age group if required. Although we can not guarantee that the teams from the same club would avoid playing each other in the festival fixtures.

- 1995 (under 12s) – Two teams per club planned for one to play the afternoon of 5th May with the other team playing afternoon of 6th May.
- 1996 (under 11s) – Two teams per club planned for one to play the afternoon of 5th May with the other team playing afternoon of 6th May
- 1997 (under 10s) – One team per club playing Sunday morning 6th May
- 1998 (under 9s) – Two teams per club one team playing Saturday morning 5th May and the other team playing Sunday morning 6th May
- 1999 (under 8s) – One team per club playing Saturday morning 5th May
- 2000 (under 7s) – One team per club playing Saturday 5th May starting at midday. Each team will play 3 games with 5 minutes between each game.
- Official referees will be used for all games

All the above age groups will be playing non competitive 7-a-side and all participants will receive a commemorative medal from a fun day out. We will have Kenny Arthur, Partick Thistle goalkeeper, starting the festival and handing out the medals. There will be a 20-minute break between games for all teams.

The entry fee for the festival will be £40 per team, except for the 2000s, which will be £25 per team, and all responses, along with payment, are to be sent to the address listed at the bottom of this letter as soon as possible as places are beginning to fill up. Cheques are to be made payable to Newtown Wanderers.

On receipt of confirmation from your club we will provide you with an information pack regarding the full scale of the festival.

We will have attractions for example; bouncy castles, slides and an inflatable assault course as well as some fun competitions to keep everyone entertained between games.

NEWTOWN WANDERERS FESTIVAL - SOCCER SEVENS RULES

The Field of Play

The field of play is determined according to National Guidelines.

Goalposts

(4.9m x 1.8m is maximum size but minimum sizes can also be used)

Teams

Teams will comprise 6 outfield players plus a goalkeeper. Team squads may consist of up to 11 players with rolling substitutions used throughout the match. Players who have been substituted may return to the field of play as often as necessary.

The Ball

All age groups to use a size 4 football.

Offside

There is no offside rule.

Duration of Game

The duration of game shall be consistent 15 minutes each game.

Match Referee

Match referee's decision is final and should be adhered to at all times.

Kick-Ins/Throw-Ins

Under 7's and 8's age groups should use kick-ins. All other age groups are to use throw-ins. In the event of the ball going out of play a kick-in or throw-in will be awarded. At all kick-ins or throw-ins and the taking of free kicks in Soccer Sevens, opposition players must be 6 metres from the ball.

Re-start

Play should be re-centred after a goal has been scored with the opposing team at least 6 metres from the ball.

Equipment

All players must wear shin-guards. Metal studs are not suitable for any pitches. Spectacles may be worn provided they have safety frames and lenses.

Pass Back Rule

The pass back rule does not apply.

Penalty Kicks

Penalty kicks shall be taken 7 metres from goal line.

Goalkeepers

Goalkeepers may kick or throw the ball out as preferred. However, kick out's constantly travelling more than the half way line should be given back to goalkeeper and the kick should be re-taken. Goalkeepers attempting to gather the ball by hand may not be challenged.

Coaches

All team coaches must promote fair play at all times and show due respect to all other participants or face being asked to leave the festival.

Player Behaviour

Team coaches should substitute players displaying unacceptable behaviour.
