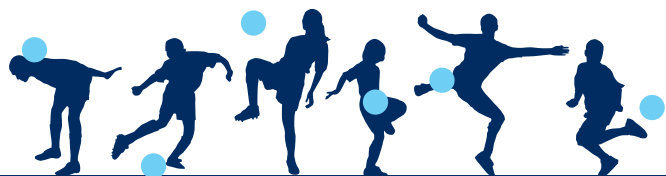

## Other Information

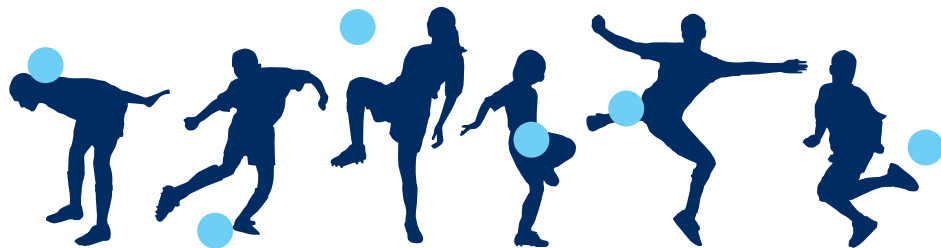
- Each course member will receive a Skill Ball/other gift.

Payment of fee will be considered a course member's acceptance of these Conditions of Enrolment.

No confirmation will be sent. All applications will be accepted unless otherwise informed.

Applications are accepted on a first come first served basis. Although applications will be accepted up to course commencement, it should be noted that a course will be cancelled if there are insufficient applicants twenty one days prior to the proposed date.

All fees must be paid in full no later than seven days prior to course commencement.

The Association/Football Development Officer reserves the right to cancel or amend arrangements for any course. In this event, any course member unable to transfer to an alternative course will be

issued with a full refund, and the Association/Football Development Officer will not be responsible for any further compensation.

The coaching staff are not responsible for youngsters prior to daily course commencement or after daily course conclusion.

Intimation of cancellation on a course member's part must be given in writing, and received by the Association at least seven days prior to course commencement. In this event a full refund will be issued.
